CyclePoint... if you haven't heard, MARC has started a new venture. The first ever e-waste community collection drive for MARC's CyclePoint program took place at 3939 Lien Road on December 4, 2015. Since then MARC has held two additional collections events on Jan 9th and Feb 13th. Volunteers have been on hand to assist with the collection of e-waste items. All of the events have been successful, generating approximately 6000 pounds of e-waste. The items collected will create employment opportunities for people with significant disabilities as they are safely de-manufactured and prepared for downstream recycling. The collection drives help the environment by diverting e-waste from landfills.
